The names of the candidates will be arranged upon the ballot in party columns, so that a voter desiring to vote a straight party ticket may do so by making a cross in the circle at the top of the column assigned to the party of his choice. A cross mark in such a circle is a vote not only for a Representative in Congress and for General Officers, but also for members of the General Assembly; therefore This Ballot Must Not Be Torn Apart, Nor Its Folds Separated In Any Manner Whatsoever. The Entire Ballot must be returned to the State Returning Board, which, by the changes made in the laws at the January Session,...
