It contains the first three volumes of the Registers of Dewsbury, and covers the period from 1538 to 1653. There are a few intervals in the first volume, which, until it was bound and its leaves were mounted at the Public Record Office a few years ago, was in a very bad state, all the leaves being loose, and some of them being much frayed. I am responsible for the transcript of the first volume, and for comparing the proof sheets of the first and second volumes with the originals. I also compared the proof sheets of the third volume of the Registers with the transcript. The second and third volumes were transcribed by Miss Pattie Osler at the British Museum, where they were under the care of Mr. J. P. Anderson until they were copied; and the transcript of the third volume, which in parts is much faded, was compared with the original by Mr. W. Paley Baildon, who kindly volunteered his services. The Index has been partly prepared by Mr. W. W. Yates and his daughter, Miss Yates, and has been completed by two of my daughters. It contains some peculiar names, and records many varieties in the spelling of the more common names. On the whole, however, the entries are not particularly interesting. We find frequent references to Lee Fair, and Care Sunday is often mentioned. Some Accounts of the Churchwardens appear on page 29. The Plague is mentioned on pages 50 and 51. Then we find Crosse Week, page 92; Plowe...
