In the construction of the ash and fuel cars, special care was taken to protect the power plant workmen from injury. The cars were built so as to avoid sharp corners, knobs taking the place of the square joints at each of the four top corners. The cars are all of 40 cubic feet capacity and are equipped with the Koppel structure. To eliminate the expense and delay of handling the ashes, these cars are provided with a flexible chute. The track is so located on the conveying elevator, shown in the diagram, that when the elevator is raised above the level of the floor, the chute is let down and the ashes discharge directly into a wagon outside the building. The fuel cars are a standard square box type with doors on one side arranged to...
